ENTRANTS - PLEASE TAKE A MOMENT TO READ THIS IN FULL BEFORE YOU ARRIVE AT POWERCRUISE

We are pleased to advise that we have received your entry into the wildest cruising car show in Oz. <u>Please take the time to have a good</u> <u>read of this letter</u> and also download your copy of the Event Guide from <u>www.powercruise.com</u> the event guide has all of the information that you need to know as an entrant at Powercruise and we guarantee that it will make your weekend run much smoother. GETTING IN, ACCREDITATION & SAFETY INSPECTION:

Accreditation & Safety inspection is located just prior to Gate A of Sydney Motorsport Park, off Ferrers Road. Do not proceed to the gate until you have been through Accreditation & Safety Inspection.

• ACCREDITATION: All Entrants must Sign In at the Accreditation office as your FIRST STOP.

This is the only place where entrants can sign in and collect your Entrant Armbands & Stickers. Please bring Yourself (The Entered driver), Your Car, Your Driver's Licence & Your RACERS Clubman Licence. Please note that only the entrant can collect their armbands, stickers or passes, so please do not send your mates.

- SAFETY INSPECTION: All cars MUST undergo a safety inspection before they can drive on track.
 Powercruise Safety Inspection Staff will be outside the accreditation office inspecting cars in the line up. It is the entrants responsibility to ensure your car meets or exceeds our car & safety requirements, if you are unsure of these requirements please refer to the website or event guide. Read below for more info on the Safety Inspection process. Safety is Everyone's Responsibility.
- Once you have been through Accreditation and Safety Inspection you are OK to head on in and set up for the big weekend ahead. You only need to go through Accreditation and Safety Inspection once, so you do not need to come back again unless you have problems or questions. If you are unsure of anything please ask the Powercruise staff at the Accreditation Office.
 Once you have received your entrant wristband and vehicle stickers, they must remain on for the duration of the event. Broken or tampered wristbands are null and void. Your Wristbands, Stickers & Lanyards are your responsibility. If you experience any issues with your wristbands or stickers you must return to the accreditation office with them and get it sorted as a priority.

ACCREDITATION OFFICE & SAFETY INSPECTION HOURS:

Thursday 27th February2pm – 10pmThe accreditation office will be open on Thursday from 2pm to 10pm. This is so you can get all of your paperwork sorted & set up camp, so
come Friday morning you'll spend less time in line ups and more time on the track. (No general spectator access on Thursday – Entrants and
Camping pass holders only. No track activities, no day spectator or general admission Thursday.)

Friday 28 th February	8am – 8pm
Saturday 1 st March	8am – 6pm
Sunday 2 nd March	8am – 10am

After going through Accreditation & Safety Inspection, Entrants Access Via Gate A Sydney Motorsport Park. Gate A will remain open 24hours Thursday, Friday & Saturday nights for Entrants and Camping pass holders so you can come and go if required. No Day Pass admission on Thursday.

Entrants Arriving Outside Office Hours – Entrants must arrive during accreditation office hours to receive all pre-paid items, if arriving late/out of those hours you will be required to purchase a Weekend Camping Pass at the gate, keep your wristband on until the morning, then report to Accreditation once it re-opens in the morning to process your entry and we will also refund you for the ticket purchased the night before.

DRIVERS LICENCE & RACERS LICENCE REQUIREMENTS: At the accreditation office you will be required to produce your valid drivers' licence - no exceptions! We must sight your VALID driver's licence (physical card or LIVE digital Licence), so if you don't bring your licence, its expired, damaged or unreadable, then you won't be driving on the track. We cannot accept a photo or screenshot. If you are in the process of renewing or awaiting a replacement licence, you must have Photo ID and Proof of licence renewal with you on the day to satisfy our ID and licence requirements, if this applies to you please call before the event to ensure you bring everything we need to see on the day. ID must be government issued ID, we will not accept a Racers licence (or any other motorsport licence) as Identification. RACERS Clubman Licence: You must also present your valid RACERS Clubman Licence. Available at <u>www.racers.world</u>

Car Standards & Safety Requirements<u>HERE</u> Drivers Briefing Video <u>HERE</u> Download Event Guide <u>HERE</u> Cars can be left on car trailers or tilt trays for the safety inspection, but if you bring your car on a truck or enclosed trailer you may need to unload it before it can be inspected.

We will be getting through everyone as fast as we can, but here are a few things that you can do to make the process a little faster.... - Please do not leave your car unattended in the line, the entrant should make their way to the Accreditation office and have a mate stay with the car to keep the line moving.

- Make sure you have your driver's licence and this letter with you before you get to the office window.

- If you need to unload your car, please do not do it in the line up

-It's the entrants responsibility to ensure your car meets or exceeds our Car Standards and Safety requirements.

If you have purchased a Garage or Carport, your Pit Lane Access Sticker/s & allocation will be given to you or your allocated entrants when you register at the accreditation office, please read information below on support vehicles. You must nominate entrants using your garage/carport prior to the event office. Stickers will not be issued without this information. Any Garage/Carport changes or transfers must be processed through the Powercruise Office. If you have booked a carport or garage and want to be next to a mate who has booked the same thing – you must request this at the time of booking, do not leave this to the last minute as we cannot rearrange allocations at the event. Please note, garages & carports come with a P sticker for priority access to the cruise sessions – but garages & carports are not the same as VIP entry. The area in front or behind garages/carports is not part of the garage or carport purchase, and is allocated to other customers.

CANCELLING, CAN'T MAKE IT, CHANGING CAR OR CHANGED PLANS: You can view our full refund & cancellation policy online HERE.

If your car isn't finished in time you can change your entered car, but the entered driver cannot be changed, we would prefer this in writing before the event, but it can be changed on the day at accreditation if you need to. If you plan to change car on the day, it is your responsibility to ensure you car meets our car standards and safety requirements.

You can request to receive spectator tickets to the credit of your entry fee, please email our office at least 3 days before the event starts to arrange or within 3 days of the event this can only be done in person at the accreditation office at the event. (You can use these for yourself or gift them for friends/family)

For standard entrants a refund of the entry fee only less a \$40 administration fee can be requested if you request to cancel in writing no later than 14 days prior to the event (VIP is non-refundable sorry).

VIP Entrants can transfer their VIP package to another person – please contact the Powercruise Office OR See VIP staff for full options/info for VIP entrants.

DRIVERS BRIEFING: All entrants must view the 7 minute drivers briefing DVD before they will be allowed to drive on the track, the drivers briefing session will outline what behaviour is and is not welcome on the track. All of this information is also outlined in the event guide available at <u>www.powercruise.com</u>. Driver briefing will start Thursday evening & continue throughout the weekend, please check your program for times. Driver briefing will start on Thursday night in the Hinxman Room, above the Garages closest to the control tower, check your map for exact location.

NOTICE TOO ALL DRIVERS: If you come off the track at any time or during any event, reduce speed immediately, and return to the track at low speed. Do not carelessly rip up the grass or track edges. If you come off the track, continue accelerating and carelessly cause damage to the grass and track edges, you will lose a drivers briefing armband, or more. There will be zero tolerance for international or careless damage to the track edges.

No Static Burnouts ever, No driving on rims ever, No Donuts during cruising ever. As these activities are dangerous and can damage the track surface and should you break these rules you will lose your driving privileges at Powercruise for the weekend. It is your responsibility to make yourself aware of the rules as outlined in the Driver Briefing DVD & Event Guide, and follow them.

Drifting in the Cruise Sessions will not be tolerated and result in loss of your Drivers Briefing armband or Driving privileges. Do not expect leniency, Powercruise will enforce all rules outlined in the Driver Briefing Video, and there will be zero tolerance to dangerous or careless behaviour at any time.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ENTRANTS If you plan to take part in the Competition Events at Powercruise (Burnouts, Powerskids & Off Street Racing) you will need neck to wrist to ankle non-flammable type clothing, plus a full face Australian Standards Helmet and enclosed footwear. Enclosed foot wear is required by drivers and passengers at all times on track.

When setting up your camp or pits, you must not drive any pegs through the bitumen. Please also be aware venue rules are that fuel can only be brought in 20l drums for safety reasons. If you have not booked a garage, carport or VIP Package, you are not eligible to set up a pit anywhere beyond the tunnel or on any of the bitumen/hardstand areas, these areas are all booked/reserved prior to the event. Support cars & trailers must be parked in designated areas, no support car or trailer parking through the tunnel.

Once you have received your entrant wristband and vehicle stickers, they must remain on for the duration of the event. If you experience any problems, or accidental breakages with your wristbands or stickers you must see your VIP staff to get it sorted ASAP. Please note any wristband breakages can only be replaced as an exchange for the original wristband. Abuse of our staff is NOT ACCEPTABLE and will not change rules in your favour, if you have questions or issues please use the appropriate manner and channels. SUPPORT VEHICLES Support vehicles will not be permitted through the tunnel for access to the main pit area at any time over the

<u>weekend</u>, this is the area behind the garages, this is thanks to entrants at previous events doing the wrong thing and parking support vehicles behind garages and blocking areas reserved to other customers and not moving them, so support vehicles will not be permitted in this area at all, and not permitted through the tunnel.

Thursday afternoon and each evening after the track activities have finished will be the best time for support vehicles to drop supplies

into garages & carports. We suggest you prepare accordingly, bring a trolley or make arrangements to move your gear around in your entered car. There is a trailer & support vehicle parking area just before the tunnel for carport & garage holders.

Entrants camping in the camping grounds can park their support cars/trailers in the camping grounds near their campsite.

Once again these strict access restrictions are for safety reasons to ensure access for emergency vehicles is always kept open and thanks for previous entrants leaving their support vehicles in all the wrong places all weekend we have no choice but to be strict – so please take note of the advice in this section and do the right thing so we don't have to be harsher in the future.

PASSENGERS: Over the weekend there will be hours of cruising, so spectators can jump in their mates car, and cruise the track alongside hundreds of like-minded petrolheads... that's what Powercruise is about after all... doing all the things you're not allowed to do anywhere else! However there are a few special requirements all passengers should be aware of...

All passengers who want to get on track in the cruising sessions MUST be at least 13 years of age and have a Powercruise admission ticket to the event and each passenger must have an official Powercruise passenger wristband. Official Powercruise passenger wristbands are available at the Powercruise merchandise stand at the event. All passengers must complete the Powercruise passenger waiver form and pay the \$10* passenger fee, once this is done Powercruise staff will issue you a Powercruise passenger wristband. Please read carefully below to ensure you meet the requirements:

Persons 18yrs of age and older must have a valid Powercruise admission ticket to the event, provide Photo ID and fill out and sign the indemnity form, pay the \$10* Fee and a Passenger Wristband will be provided. No matter your age, No Photo ID = No passenger wristband. Persons 13 years of age and over, but younger than 18 years of age must have a valid Powercruise admission ticket to the event, provide Photo ID for themselves, and have a PARENT present to sign the indemnity form on their behalf. Powercruise staff need to sight both the parent's ID and the child's photo ID, both must also show the date of birth. Powercruise staff will also request to sight the Medicare Card listing both the Parents and Childs Names as proof of relationship. Powercruise reserve the right to request further identification or documentation if the requirements are not satisfied.

Powercruise staff will only accept the legal parent to sign on behalf of a minor to be a passenger – we <u>cannot</u> accept other family members, step parents, day carers/guardians, neighbours, family friends etc. Passenger wristbands can only be issued on the day at Powercruise. We do not accept notes, letters or permission via phone from parents if they cannot attend – Both the Parent and the Minor must be present at the event at the same time to complete the paperwork under the instruction of a Powercruise Staff Member. Once both the parent and the child have completed and signed the indemnity form and paid the \$10* fee, a passenger wristband will be provided.

<u>Persons 12 years of age and younger</u> are unfortunately too young and cannot be a passenger in a vehicle at Powercruise. Admission is Free for Kids 12 & Under

Powercruise Passenger Rules & Requirements are not flexible or negotiable. Passenger Wristbands do not entitle that person to drive. Event Admission is additional to Passenger Sign On \$10* Fee.

The Passenger Sign on fee is discounted to \$10 for Powercruise Ticket Holders Only (Full Price is \$20). Passengers are permitted during the cruising sessions, and at some events, 1 front passenger is permitted in the Burnout events/sessions, this can vary from event to event, please check each events program for more information. Helmets and safety gear is not required to ride in a car during the cruise sessions, but **passengers are required to wear enclosed shoes and a seatbelt at all times**. Events where a passenger in the burnouts is permitted, this person is required to wear all the same safety gear as the driver; which is a helmet, enclosed shoes, and neck to wrist to ankle non flammable clothing.

Powercruise anyone who is pregnant may not participate in any on track activities in any way.

All passengers must be suitably restrained to the satisfaction of Powercruise Staff and Officials. All Passenger Wristbands are issued at the discretion of Powercruise Staff and Powercruise Staff reserve the right to decline or retract passenger wristbands or participation at their discretion at any time. Passenger wristbands must be kept on for the duration of your time at the Powercruise Event. Any cut or tampered wristbands are null and void and will be confiscated without discussion. Passenger Rules & Requirements are subject to change without notice.

Passenger sign on will also be available at the Powercruise Accreditation Office at the event for any parents that are attending just to sign their child up, the accreditation office is located outside the venue so this can be done without parents having to go into the event and pay admission – call Powercruise on <u>0407 172 413</u> for more information or if you can't find the Accreditation Office.

Powercruise is an alcohol free event. This doesn't mean we are giving away free alcohol!!! It means alcohol will not be sold inside the venue and you are not permitted to bring your own alcohol, all cars entering the venue will be searched and any alcohol found will be tipped out, so do yourself a favour & leave it on the shelf in the shed.

We'd also like to advise all entrants that the police will have a presence outside of the venue, therefore if you are driving an illegal or defective vehicle you can expect the same treatment as you would receive on any other road. So we suggest that if your vehicle is defective that you trailer it to and from the event. The public will be safer and you could save \$\$ in fines, so be a sport and don't take the risk.

Safety on and off the track at any Powercruise event is the most important aspect of the event's future. Therefore all Powercruise entrants need to be aware that any unruly or antisocial behaviour either while driving on the track or walking in the pits will not be tolerated and will be dealt with by the Police and your participation at future Powercruise events will end. Powercruise will have zero tolerance for dangerous or careless behaviour of any kind, anywhere at the event.

Please read your event guide as it has EVERYTHING you will need to know about Powercruise and check out the venue map to familiarise yourself with where everything is, all this info is available on our website <u>www.powercruise.com</u> or you can call us on 0407 172 413. As a Powercruise entrant you are helping mould the future for our brand of motor sport, so be a sport. Have a great time and more importantly a safe event and if you think you have what it takes to give me a run down the front straight, bring it on....
